- Ability to model cultural integration and professionalism and to provide guidance and technical support to adults.
- Ability to prepare required technical reports and evaluations in a timely manner.
- Basic understanding of Microsoft Office, Excel, Outlook and other computer use.
- Must pass a security clearance before beginning employment.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Experience in training Peace Corps Volunteers or volunteers or staff in other international volunteer programs.
- Basic conversational Guarani.
- Experience in leading training in working with youth groups and/or other community based organizations.
- Knowledge of Paraguayan culture and current economic development issues.
- Valid Paraguayan driver's license and ability to drive a manual (stick shift), four-wheel drive vehicle.
- Able to travel throughout Paraguay as requested.
